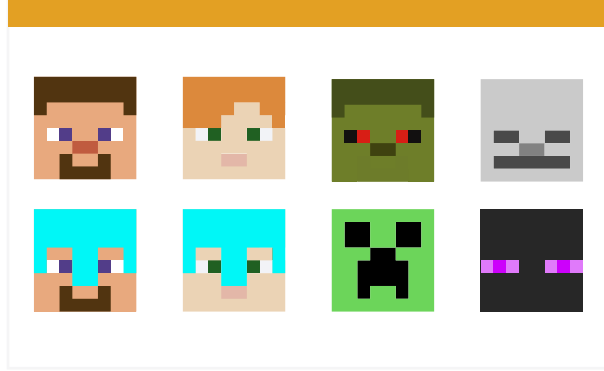
Minecraft Castle Build Challenge: Design, Create, Code
